

Muhlhauser Road widening subject of December 20 public meeting

The widening of Muhlhauser Road will be discussed at a public Forum scheduled Wednesday, December 20, in the community room of the Union Township Building, located at the corner of Cincinnati-Dayton and Beckett Roads. Representatives from various agencies involved in the project will be available to answer questions and discuss the project between 4 - 7 p.m.

The meeting will feature an open Forum so that those interested in the project can stop in anytime between 4 - 7 p.m. and talk with representatives knowledgeable about the project.

In addition to engineering plans and displays detailing the widening project, representatives from the Butler County Transportation Improvement District (TID), the Butler County Engineer's Office, and Bayer and Becker Engineering Consultants will be available. A right-of-way consultant will also be available so property owners adjacent to the road project can discuss any concerns regarding right-of-way or necessary land acquisitions.

Previously announced widening plans call for Muhlhauser Road to be widened to four lanes from State Route 747 to International Boulevard.
